We are looking to recruit readers interested in supporting a window of opportunity study, MEDICI.

MEDICI is a study which seeks to determine whether changes in mammographic density can be used as imaging biomarkers for the effectiveness of adjuvant endocrine therapy. We are looking for collaborators who would be willing to assess the mammographic breast density on a series of images.

We are hoping to collaborate with a further 3-9 professionals who report mammograms (symptomatic or screening) within their NHS clinical practice. We anticipate it will require 6-12 hours work over a period of 4-6 months from May 2024. All collaborators will be named as co-authors on subsequent presentations and publications.
